

# Master of Science Degree in Kinesiology or Exercise Physiology at UNLV

- Students are admitted in the fall, spring, and summer semesters.
- Applicants for admission must have an undergraduate major in kinesiology, exercise science, physical education, athletic training, biology, or a related academic discipline. If admission is sought by individuals who do not have these majors, then up to 18 credit hours of prescribed undergraduate course work may be required before admission can be considered.
- Applicants must have a minimum undergraduate grade point average of 2.75 or 3.00 in the last two years.
- The Graduate Record Examination (GRE) must be taken prior to applying. A 3.00 undergraduate GPA and a combined score of 1000 is normally expected.

## Items required by Graduate College:

- Graduate Application - Visit the UNLV Graduate College website.
- Official Transcripts (GPA >3.0) Official transcripts of all colleges and universities attended, are to be sent to the Graduate College.

## Items required by Dept. Of Kinesiology:

- Letter of Intent
- Letters of Reference (2)
- Copies of Graduate Application and Transcripts
- GRE: 1000 or greater

In addition, two letters of reference, a statement of intent and copies of application and transcripts should be sent to the Department of Kinesiology.

Prospective students should keep personal copies of all data submitted.

The deadline for applying for a **graduate assistantship** is normally February 1 for Kinesiology Master Degrees (this date is not for Athletic Training Internship Admission)
