



## **GRE Admissions Exam Policy & Tips**

### **Which exam is required for the MHA application?**

The Department of Health Care Administration & Policy accepts the GMAT or GRE.

### **Can the exam requirement be waived?**

Exemptions are available for those who have taken alternate graduate entry tests (e. g. MCAT, LSAT) and were accepted to law school or medical school, or those who have a terminal degree (e. g., PhD, JD, MD, DNP).

### **Does the GRE or GMAT have to be taken prior to applying to the Program?**

Schedule your GRE before you apply to the program, and provide your exam date in your personal statement, if you have not already submitted your exam scores at time of application. If you are applying for a GA position, your GRE score is an important qualifier, so prepare carefully and do your best!

### **Is a minimum score required on the exam and how does UNLV receive my results?**

No, but students with a 40<sup>th</sup> – 50<sup>th</sup> percentile score or better are best positioned for admission, unless they have a strong GPA. Your score is evaluated in concert with the other merits of your application, including your undergraduate GPA, your work experience and personal statement, and your recommendation letters. Preparing over a 2-6 month period is highly recommended to achieve the best score. When taking the exam, you will be asked which schools you want your results sent to.
